SCHEDULE 3

COMMERCIAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available to consumers throughout the territory for commercial and industrial use including lighting, heating and power, subject to the established Rules and Regulations of the Cooperative. Customer shall contract for a demand of not less than 15 KW.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase or three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

Customer charge rate \$15.00
Demand charge, all KW, per KW rate \$10.00
Energy charge, all KWH, per KWH rate \$0.08560

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in the Cooperative's service Rules and Regulations. The charges billed under this section are subject to a late payment rate.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the demand charge.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the greatest of the following:

- A. The maximum kilowatt demand established by the customer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter, and adjusted for power factor as provided in the service contract.
- B. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the highest recorded demand over the previous eleven (11) months.
- C. Fifteen (15) KW demand.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid in full on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill, which shall be least 20 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1 ½%) on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.


TERM

Minimum length of service is one (1) year, after which service may be terminated with forty-eight (48) hours written notice unless other conditions have been specified in the contract for service.
